Gentlemen:

As you may be aware by now, there was a calibration error in the sampling devices used to take air measurements in a number of structures in Mesa County, including yours.

All of the readings in question have now been corrected. In your case, this changes to 0.024 WL the average radon daughter concentration noted in Section II of our report to you dated November 10, 1972. The average gamma radiation exposure rate in Section II is not affected.

This corrected reading confirms our previous recommendation that you consider corrective action.
