

ORDINANCE NO. 1480

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING MONIES TO THE
CEMETERY FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, there has been insufficient revenue to properly operate the Cemetery fund for the year 1973,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION:

1. That there be appropriated from the General Fund Account (0100-05-00) to Cemetery Revenue Fund (0800-72-01) the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) to be expended from Cemetery Fund Account (080-35-903) as may be necessary.

2. This ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and shall become effective upon passage for purpose stated.
