

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on the 6th day of February, 1974, the City Council of the City of Grand Junction considered a petition for the annexation of the following described territory to the City of Grand Junction; and

WHEREAS, the City Council determined that said territory was eligible for annexation and that no election was necessary to determine whether such territory should be annexed as the petition was signed by the owners of one hundred percent of the territory petitioned for annexation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO:

- 1. That the following described territory, to wit:

The West 488 feet of Lot 19 of Jaynes Subdivision of Section 1 of Township 1 South of Range 1 West of the Ute Meridian, Mesa County, Colorado,

be, and the same is hereby, annexed to the City of Grand Junction, Colorado.

- 2. This Ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and shall become effective upon passage for purposes stated.
