That under the provisions of 12-48-107(2), C.R.S., 1973, as amended, there shall be filed with the City Clerk with the application for a special events permit for liquor or fermented beverage license to cover actual and necessary expenses incident to the proceedings in connection with such license an application fee of \$25.00.
