

ORDINANCE NO. 1768

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO.

WHEREAS, on the 6th day of September, 1978, the City Council of the City of Grand Junction considered a petition for the annexation of the following described territory to the City of Grand Junction; and

WHEREAS, the City Council determined that said territory was eligible for annexation and that no election was necessary to determine whether such territory should be annexed as the petition was signed by the owner of one hundred percent of the territory petitioned for annexation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO:


That the following property situate in Mesa County, Colorado, to wit:

The East Half of the West Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 10, Township 1 South, Range 1 West, Ute Meridian, lying North of road right of way recorded in Book 909 at page 647, Mesa County Records, Except right of way for F Road on the North,


be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Grand Junction, Colorado.
