FIREMEN'S PENSION MEETING

June 24, 1940 -----4:15 PM.

Roll call of members Present: Bruce Brownson (City Manager), Helen C. Tomlinson
City Clerk, Francis I. Stringer, City Treasurer,
and Chas. Lowning, City Fire Chief. 4:15 PM.

City Manager, Bruce Brownson--Chairman.

Motion made by Helen C. Tomlinson that Francis I. Stringer be elected
Secretary and Treasurer of meeting. Sec. by Lowning, motion carried.

Motion made by Francis I. Stringer that Bruce Brownson be elected President
of the Firemen's Pension Board. Sec. by Helen C. Tomlinson--motion carried.

The purpose of the meeting was discussion and disposition of disability
lems of Assistant Fire Chief, Joe Cerney, who is physically unable to
completely carry out any of his duties as a fireman. After reading the
concerning disability of Joe Cerney, a motion was made by Chas. Lowning
that he be permanently pensioned and that the \$14.00 per week State
Compensation Insurance check which he now receives be paid back to the
Firemen's Pension Fund until the date of his one half retirement pay start
which is July 1, 1940. And that on July 1, 1940 he shall receive from the
Firemen's Pension Fund one half of his former pay, or \$75.00 per month, and
also any settlement he may hereafter receive from the State Compensation I
Fund. Motion sec. by Francis I. Stringer--motion carried.
