FIREMEN'S PENSION MEETING  
JAN 30, 1944-----10AM


Roll call of members present: Bruce Brownson, Helen C. Tomlinson,  
Francis I. Stringer, Chas Downing.

City Mgr. Bruce Brownson--Chairman.

Joe Brady having been elected as representative of G.J. Firemen's Pension Fund of Grand Junction, Colo. attended his first meeting.

Chairman Bruce Brownson announced the purpose of said meeting as being the matter of acting on the retirement pension of former Chief Chas. Downing. Downing having had twenty, 20, years continuous service and past 50 years of age is eligible for a pension.

Chas Downing resigned as of Nov. 30, 1943. During the 1st eleven months of 1943 he received a monthly salary of \$215.00 per month and Dec. 1943 he received \$205.00, thus making his pension  $\frac{1}{2}$  of his salary for the twelve preceding months as being \$107.09. All members agreed and voted for Chas. Downing to be retired on said amount.

No further business- Meeting adjourned.
