That being the case, the Board feels that justice demands that the action of the board on June 24, 1940, be reconsidered, and that the question as to whether or not you are entitled to disability payments from the Firemen's Pension Fund be again inquired into.

A Hearing will be held at the City Hall in Grand Junction, Colorado, on JUNE 15, 1943, at 10:00 A.M. for the purpose of discovering whether such disability yet continues and whether you should be continued on the pension roll, at which time you should be present, and at which time you may be represented by counsel and may introduce evidence in your own behalf.
