FIREMEN'S PENSION BOARD MEETING

May 16, 1952

A meeting of the Firemen's Pension Board was called at 3:00 P. M. in the office of the City Manager, May 16, 1952. Board members present were City Manager Toyne, Joe Brady, Frank Kreps, Fred Hagie and Helen C. Tomlinson. Also, Al Gavin who was appointed at this meeting.

The law having been changed so as to require three firemen on the Firemen's Pension Board, Al Gavin was chosen as the third member as required by Section 476 Chapter 163 of the Colorado Statutes.

The primary purpose of the meeting was to discuss a death benefit for the widow of the recently deceased fireman, Joe Cerney.

It was moved by Joe Brady that the widow of Joe Cerney receive a death benfit of \$100 as set out by Section 482, Chapter 163, of the Colorado Statutes. Frank Kreps seconded the motion and all present voted "AYE."

Helen Tomlinson moved that a burial fee be paid the widow and Cerney's regular pension to May 15, 1952, after which time the widow would receive a pension at the rate of \$50.00 per month. The motion was seconded by Gavin with all members of the Board in favor.

The City Manager declared the meeting adjourned.
