DECEMBER 22, 1971


Attendance: Richard Gray, Cecil C. Campbell, Clarence Cooper,

The meeting was called to consider a letter from Mr. A. H. Gavin noting his retirement from the City Fire Department and requesting board action to establish his pension as of January 1, 1972.

It was moved by Cecil Campbell and seconded by Clarence Cooper that Engineer-Mechanic A. H. Gavin be granted his pension as of January 1, 1972 at half pay. The pension for 1972 shall be 50% of \$694.00 or \$347.00 per month. Mr. Gavin will be entitled to the escalator clause in future years. Passed unanimously.
