

ORDINANCE NO. 2129

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AN ALLEY IN THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the alley hereinafter described has been petitioned for vacation; and

WHEREAS, such vacation has been approved by the Planning Commission and would not be detrimental to the inhabitants of the City of Grand Junction;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION:

That an existing alley right-of-way more particularly described as follows:

A strip of land 20 feet wide immediately south of Lots 1 through 9, and the West 9.07 feet of Lot 10, and immediately North of the West 9.07 feet of Lot 23, and Lots 24 through 32, all in Block 81, CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION,

be and the same is hereby vacated.
