## **SPECIAL SESSION MINUTES**

## February 20, 2019

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado met in Special Session on Wednesday, February 20, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. in the Administration Conference Room, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, City Hall, 250 North 5<sup>th</sup> Street.
