

PLAT OF DUNDEE PLACE

Know all men by these Presents that The Western Slope Securities Company, a Corporation existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Colorado, have caused the following described tract of land to be surveyed and platted as shown on this plat to wit: Commencing at a point where the North line of Grand Avenue in the City of Grand Junction projected East intersects the West line of Section Thirteen (13) of Township One (1) South in Range One (1) West of the Ute Meridian, Mesa County, Colorado, thence East along the said North line of Grand Avenue a distance of Thirteen Hundred Twenty and Eight tenths (1320 8/10) feet to the East line of the South-West quarter of the North-West quarter of said Section Thirteen (13) thence North along said East line of (SW 1/4 NW 1/4) a distance of Six Hundred Eighty-six and Six-tenths (686 6/10) feet to the intersection of the center line of Chipeta Avenue projected East, thence West along said center line of Chipeta Avenue to its intersection with the West line of said Section Thirteen (13) a distance of Thirteen Hundred twenty one and six tenths (1321 6/10) feet, thence South along the said West line of Section Thirteen, a distance of Six hundred Eighty-six and Six-tenths (686 6/10) feet to the place of beginning. Also beginning on the West line of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section Thirteen Twp 1S R 1W West of the Ute Meridian in Mesa County Colorado at the point of its intersection with the South line of Grand Avenue Grand Junction Colorado, at its Eastern terminus, thence East parallel with the South line of said SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 13 according to Government Survey, 1320 feet more or less to the East line of said SW 1/4 of Section 13 thence North 100 feet, thence West parallel to same South line of SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 13, to its West line, and to the North line of Grand Avenue at its Eastern terminus, thence South to the place of beginning and also the South 12 feet of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 13 Twp 1S R 1W of the Ute Meridian in Mesa County Colorado




Commencing at a point where the North Line of Grand Avenue in the City of Grand Junction projected East intersects the West line of Section Thirteen (13) of Township One (1) South in Range One (1) West of the Ute Meridian, Mesa County Colorado Thence East along the said North line of Grand Avenue a distance of Thirteen hundred Twenty and Eight tenths (1320.8) feet to the East line of the South-west quarter of the North-West quarter of said Section Thirteen (13) Thence North along the said East line (S.W. 1/4 N.W. 1/4) a distance of Six hundred Eighty-six and six-tenths (686.6) feet to the intersection of the center line of Chipeta Avenue projected East Thence West along said center line of Chipeta Avenue to its intersection with the West line of said Section Thirteen (13) a distance of Thirteen hundred Twenty-one and six-tenths (1321.6) feet Thence south along the said West line of Section Thirteen a distance of six hundred Eighty-six and six-tenths (686.6) feet to the place of beginning. Also beginning on the West line of the S.W. 1/4 of the NW. 1/4 of Section 13, 100' S. 1/2 W. of the Ute Meridian in Mesa County Colorado, at the point of its intersection with the South line of Grand Avenue, Grand Junction Colorado at the corner terminus, thence East parallel with the South line of said S.W. 1/4 of the NW. 1/4 of Section 13, thence North 100 feet, thence west parallel to same South line of S.W. 1/4 of NW. 1/4 of Section 13, to its West line, thence to the North line of Grand Avenue at its last east terminus, thence South to the place of beginning and thence South 12 feet of the S.W. 1/4 of Section 13, Two 1/2 H. 1/2 West of the Ute Meridian in Mesa County, Colorado.
