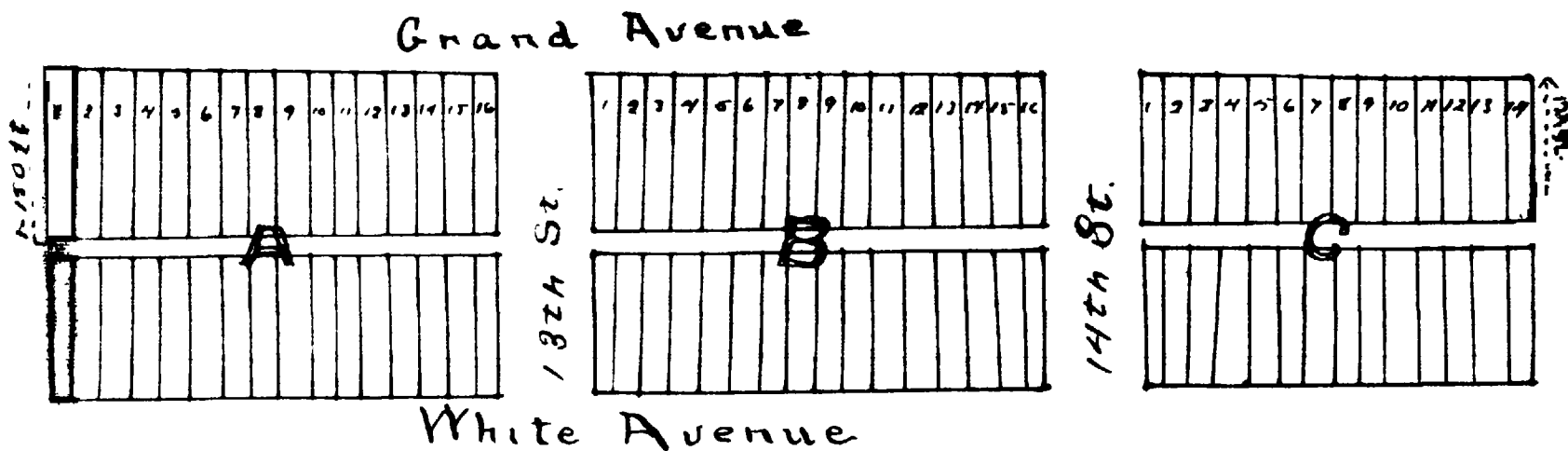


Amended Plat
