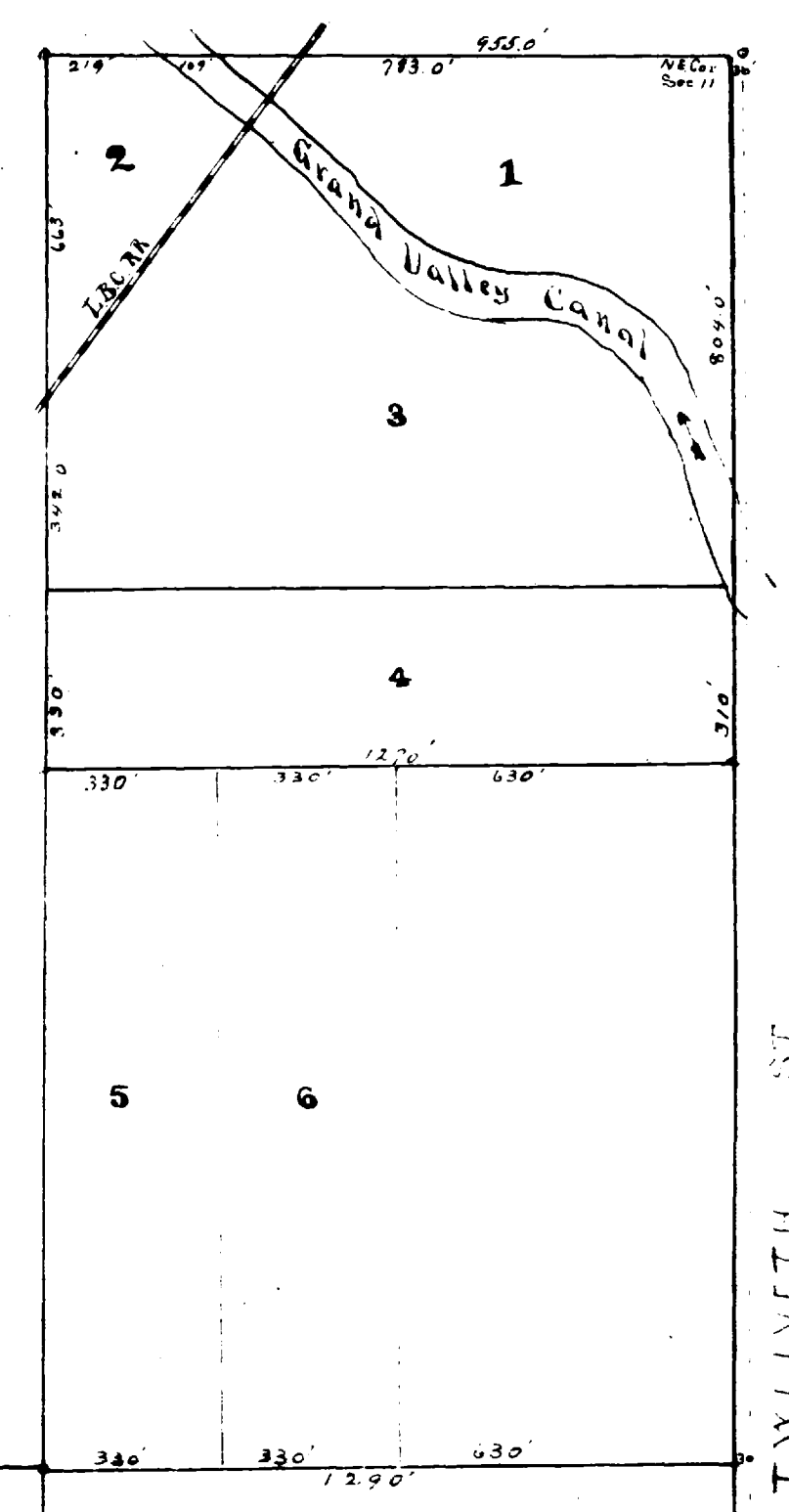


MAP

Know All Men by these presents that we Charles B. Rich and Monroe L. Allison, Trustees of the estate of Mrs. L. Mansfield, deceased, have laid out and plotted the lands described, as follows, to-wit:
 The West 1/4 Sec. 18, the E 1/4 Sec. 20, and the East 1/2 Sec. 12, S 8th, R. 11, T. 1 N. R. 2 W. 11th. All in the 2ndnd Range of Townships beginning at a point 80' South of the N.E. Cor. of Block 11, and extending North, then East, then South, then West, to the N.E. Cor. of Block 12, thence South 62.0' to the East, and then West 178.0' to the beginning.
