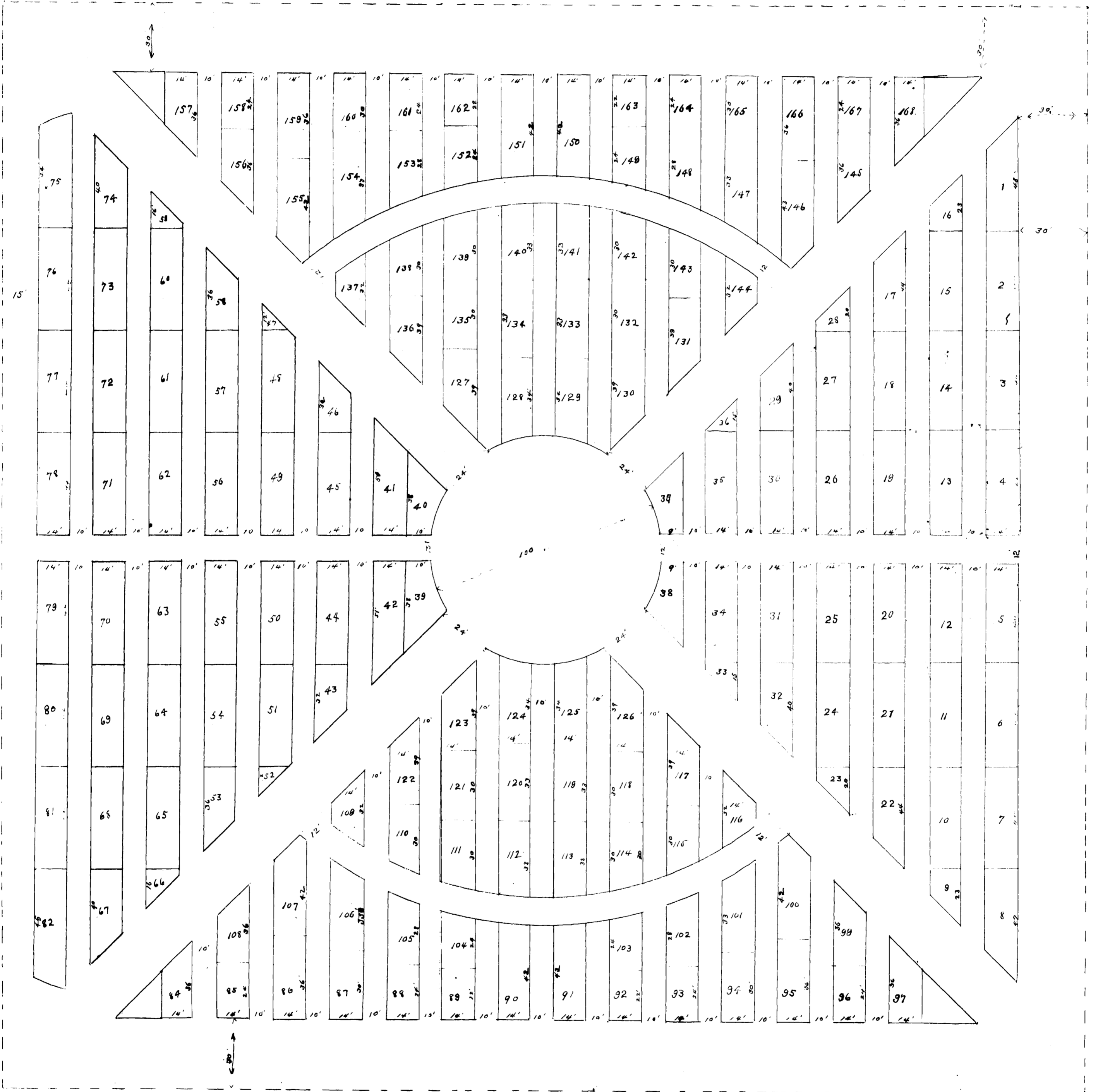

This is an *Allegory* of *Allegory* *Plat* *Mesa* *Loc. No. 55* of *Ancient Free and Accepted Masons of Grand Jurisdiction Colorado* has laid out and labeled the above book of land described as follows to wit: Commencing at the N.E. Cor. of the S.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 Sec. 26 T. 21 S. R. 41 W. 21st M. and running thence west 666 ft; thence South 666 ft; thence East 466 ft; thence North 666 ft to place of beginning. Said tract is called and laid out as the *Masonic Cemetery Grounds*, and said lodge hereby dedicates all streets alleys and avenues indicated on this plat for public use for *burial* purposes above subject to the by laws of said lodge and to the provisions of the laws of the State of Colorado now in force and applicable to be read governing letters to take in *Colorado*.
