


## PLAT

Know All Men by these Presents, That I, Melvin O. Whitehead have laid out and platted the following described tract of land, to wit:—  
Beginning at a point 466.6 ft south of the NE corner of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4, Sec 26, Twp 18, R 1W, U. S. M. and running thence west 500 ft, thence South 500 ft, thence East 500 ft, thence North 500 ft to point of beginning. Said tract is platted and laid out as "The First Subdivision of The Orchard Mesa Cemetery", and I hereby dedicate all streets and alleys indicated on this Plat to public use forever, to be used for sepulchral purposes alone, subject to the laws of the state of Colorado governing title to lots in cemeteries.
