


MAP OF

All streets and alleys are made full width.
All surpluses are thrown into the blocks and divided equally among the lots therein.
Actual width of each block and the length of each block are marked on the margin in red ink.
All range lines are set from the south and east sides of blocks except on 7th March is set from the north.
The monuments are set at the intersection of range lines and meridian lines.
