


to wit: Beginning at a point on the West line of said Sec 13, Twp and Range aforesaid, where the
South line of Gunnison Avenue in the City of Grand Junction, Mesa County, Colorado, produced
and extended East intersects the said West line of said Section 13; thence North along the said
West line of said Section 13, to the NW corner of the SW 1/4 of said Section 13 being
a distance of 190 feet, more or less, thence East to the NE corner of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4
of said Section 13; thence South along the East line of the said SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of said Sec-


