


Thank You to Our Sponsor

As you travel through the community, you may have noticed a number of construction projects underway in several parks. During the past year, it has been a priority of the Parks & Recreation Department to repair and replace much of the infrastructure in our park system including playgrounds, irrigation systems and park shelters.

Playgrounds are being replaced at Ridges Tot Lot, Hidden Valley and Duck Pond Ridges. Irrigation systems will be upgraded at Cottonwood Meadows, Dixson, Autumn Ridge and Riverside Parks. We have also added over 100 new parking spaces at Canyon View Park to help accommodate the many special events that are held there on a regular basis.

One of the most high profile projects is underway at Lincoln Park. Through a series of public meetings, we gathered input from neighbors in the area as well as frequent users of the park. As a result of their input, we have adopted a new plan which includes two new restrooms, a new picnic shelter, new playground and resurfaced tennis and pickle ball courts. The plan also includes an arboretum trail system, additional parking, and an improved entrance to the park. While much of this work is underway at this time, we anticipate final completion during the summer of 2013.

We hope that you enjoy the improved areas within your parks. We appreciate your feedback on these and other improvements to the many parks and recreational facilities throughout Grand Junction.





This chart outlines the critical prerequisite skills that determine class placement. Follow the chart to identify the class that best suits your child's skill level.



IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Aquatot 1 and Aquatot 1.5 require adult participation in the pool.
- Repetition of skills and levels is an important part of the learning process. Parents are encouraged to estimate
 their child's ability level as accurately as possible to ensure a positive experience for all swimmers.
- Springboard diving, Snorkeling, Junior Lifeguarding, and other upper-level classes are available to students who
 have completed Hydrosport or equivalent.

	Learn to Swim Descriptions
Aquatot 1 Starfish	Infants and parents work toward becoming comfortable in the pool by blowing bubbles, singing songs, playing games, and floating on their front and back. Repetition and play are important components of this class. Suggested ages 6-36 months
Aquatot 1.5 Clownfish	Toddlers work with their parents on basic skills, moving toward independence in the water in a structured class. Many skills are similar to those taught to the Guppies, but parent involvement helps ease the fear of being in the water. Class is helpful for children who are not comfortable in the pool alone with an instructor. Suggested ages 18-36 months
Aquatot 2 Guppies	Children will learn the basics of swimming, including moving independently for five yards and floating on their front and back with assistance. This class is designed to help reluctant swimmers get acclimated. It may take swimmers more than one session to complete these skills. Suggested age 3-5 years
Aquatot 3 Jellyfish	Jellyfish become completely independent from the instructor while swimming on their front and back. Once the child can swim without assistance on their front and back, and float for five seconds, they can move on to Sea Horses! It may take a few sessions for a child to master enough to move on. Suggested ages 4-5 years
Water Acclimation Sea Otters	This class is a great opportunity for older kids to participate in an entry-level class while swimming with kids of similar age. Class helps children become acclimated to the water, independently float on their front and back, explore deep water, and prepare to swim the crawl stroke and back stroke. This class may be just what older kids need to get up to speed with other swimmers their age. Suggested ages 6-12 years
Waterworks 1 Sea Horses	In the Sea Horse class, swimmers refine their front and back crawl strokes and water treading. They start learning the breaststroke, self help, and basic rescue skills. After swimming 15 yards with good stroke techniques, they can move on to Angelfish! Suggested ages 5-6 years
Waterworks 2 Angelfish	Rotary breathing for front crawl is introduced in the Angelfish class, as well as side stroke, elementary back stroke, and plenty of experience in deep water. After swimming 15-20 yards with good breathing and stroke techniques, swimmers can move up to Barracudas! Suggested ages 5-8 years
Waterworks 3 Barracudas	Class focuses on technique and endurance reinforcing positive swimming skills and building stamina. Swimmers can move on when they swim the length of the pool using front crawl, back stroke, breast stroke, side stroke, and elementary back stroke with good breathing and stroke techniques. Suggested ages 5-12 years
Waterworks 4 Stingrays	Class is designed to prepare swimmers for the pre-competitive Hammerheads class. They will learn how to do turns and swim laps in good form, nonstop, using their front and back crawl strokes, breaststroke, and sidestroke, and be introduced to the butterfly. Once the swimming requirements have been met, students will be introduced to lifesaving and rescue techniques. Suggested ages 5-15 years
Hydrosport Hammerheads	Class focuses on pre-competition skills and extended swimming. Swimmers should have a strong background in all six strokes before enrolling because a significant portion of class is dedicated to lap swimming. Lifesaving and rescue skills are also practiced. Hammerheads prepares swimmers for Springboard Diving and Junior Lifeguarding. Suggested ages 8-15 years
Springboard Diving	Springboard diving is a beginner-level diving class, focusing on the basics of competitive diving. Participants will learn various approaches, hurdles, presses, and lifts, as well as how to use the diving board safely. Divers will progress through front, back, inward, and reverse dives. Suggested ages 8 and up
Adult Workshop	The Adult Workshop is designed to provide individualized instruction for both novice and advanced swimmers. Beginning swimmers will work on improving body position, kick, breathing, and overall coordination. Swimmers looking for more advanced instruction will get tips and swim sets that will improve their form and endurance. Swimmers must be 16 years or older.
