#### Dear Mayor Kenyon,

When a new National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) map panel becomes effective, it automatically supersedes previously issued Letter of Map Change (LOMC) actions (i.e., Letters of Map Revision-based on Fill [LOMR-Fs] and Letters of Map Amendment [LOMAs]) that have been issued on that map panel, even if they are still valid and should apply to the new NFIP map as well. Because a revised NFIP map has been prepared for your community, it is necessary for the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to take administrative action to prevent valid LOMR-Fs and LOMAs from being superseded. Accordingly, the purpose of this letter is to revalidate the determinations for properties and/or structures in your community as described in the LOMR-Fs and LOMAs previously issued by FEMA on the dates listed below. As of the above-referenced effective date, these LOMR-Fs and LOMAs will revise the effective NFIP map for the referenced community, dated July 6, 2010, and will remain in effect until superseded by a revision to the NFIP map panel on which the property is located. Please be advised, the revalidation letter effective July 7, 2010, case number MICS 12759V, for the City of Grand Junction, Colorado has been superseded. All LOMR-Fs and LOMAs from that letter have been reviewed and have been incorporated into this updated revalidation letter if appropriate. Please note all LOMR-Fs and LOMAs with effective dates after July 6, 2010, on non-revised panels for your community, will remain valid until superseded by a revision to the NFIP map panel on which the property is located, such LOMCs therefore are not included in the tables below. The FEMA case numbers, when available, property identifiers, Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) Panel numbers, and current flood insurance zones of the revalidated LOMR-Fs and LOMAs are listed below.
