Request #1 - TEDS Chapter 8 – requirement for streetlights

2. <u>Site Description</u>

The purpose of this request is to make an exception from *The City of Grand Junction's Transportation Engineering Design Standards (TEDS) Chapter 8- Street Lighting.* This section of TEDS requires streetlights to be installed in the new public roads. For this project the roads are H-¹/₄ and 21-³/₄, which are both classified as collectors.

Existing Site Conditions

The 48.4 acre parcel is currently a sod farm with one single family residence on the property which will be demolished as part of the subdivision improvements. The location of the project is depicted in the photo below:



Surrounding Land Uses and Zoning

The property is located within the recently approved Northwest Area Plan that was recently annexed by the City of Grand Junction and zoned as I-1 property.

The parcels to west are in Mesa County and zoned PUD for industrial and commercial type uses. All parcels to the north, northeast and southeast are in Mesa County and are zoned AFT and or PUD and are Single-family dwellings on large parcels surrounding the site.

Proposed Site Improvements and Site Access and Circulation

This project proposes to subdivide the $48\pm$ -acre property into three industrial zoned lots. Two lots will be approximately 18-acres in size and the third lot will be approximately 5-acres in size. A shared/common stormwater detention pond will be provided in the southwest corner of the site and will be sized to handle the final build-out of all three proposed lots.

The City of Grand Junction's Northwest Area Plan calls for future east-west collector streets at H-¼ and H-½ Road between 21-½ and 22 Road. The plan also calls for a future north-south collector street at the 21-3/4 Road alignment, between H Road and H ½ Road. Therefore thirty feet (30') of Right-of-Way will be dedicated as the site's portion of H-½ Road, thirty-three feet (33') will be dedicated for H-¼ Road, and the entire sixty feet (60') of Right-of-Way for 21-¾ Road is proposed. Twenty feet (20') of asphalt will be constructed for H-¼ Road to 21-¾ Road and will continue for 750' for proper access and circulation to the northern lot and end in a culde-sac.

TEDS Section 8.1, Street Lighting, requires streetlights to be installed in H-¼ and 21-¾ Roads that are classified as collectors. At this point and time, the roads will primarily only be used during regular business hours of Monday through Friday 8 AM to 5 PM, therefore not needing any additional lighting. The public safety and welfare of the public will not be impacted as a result of granting this TEDS exception of not requiring streetlights.

REQUEST #1

A. Description

TEDS Section 8.1, Street Lighting, requires streetlights to be installed in H-¼ and 21-¾ Roads that are classified as collectors. At this point and time, the roads will primarily only be used during regular business hours of Monday through Friday 8 AM to 5 PM, therefore not needing any additional lighting. The surrounding land use and adjacent neighbors are single-family residences that won't favor the streetlights invading their privacy.

- **B.** Exception Considerations
 - How will the exception affect safety? The public safety and welfare of the public will not be impacted as a result of granting this TEDS exception of not requiring streetlights.
 - 2. Have other alternatives been considered that would meet the standard? The only other alternative would be to propose streetlight at the intersection of H-¹/₄ and 22 Road.
 - Has the proposed design been used in other areas?

 I am unaware of this exception in any other area throughout valley, however I do know of several collector streets and larger that do not have streetlights. As mentioned earlier, the only use of these roads will be between 8 AM and 5 PM when no additional light is needed.
 - 4. Will the exception require CDOT or FHWA coordination? No. None of the surrounding roads are state or federal highways.
 - 5. Is this a one-time exception or a request to change the TEDS manual? This is a simple one-time exception.
