PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the City of Grand Junction has been recognized as a Tree City USA for twenty-nine years by The National Arbor Day Foundation and desires to continue its tree-planting ways.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tom Kenyon, by the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of Grand Junction, do hereby proclaim April 21, 2012 as

"ARBOR DAY"

in the City of Grand Junction and encourage all citizens to support our City's Urban Forestry Program and to participate in this effort by planting a tree for a better future.
