- WHEREAS,** *working smoke alarms on every level, a home fire escape plan and regular drills are essential for every household in Grand Junction; and*
- WHEREAS,** *Grand Junction is joining the National Fire Protection Association in teaching lifesaving messages in conjunction with Fire Prevention Week; and*
- WHEREAS,** *the Fire Prevention Week 2008 theme, “It’s Fire Prevention Week - Prevent Home Fires”, is an important reminder for all citizens of Grand Junction.*

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, Gregg Palmer, by the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of Grand Junction, do hereby proclaim the week of October 5 through October 11, 2008, as**
