## PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS,

there are approximately 900,000 law enforcement officers serving in communities across the United States, including the dedicated members of the Grand Junction Police Department, Mesa County Sheriff's Office, Fruita Police Department, Palisade Police Department, and the Colorado State Patrol; and

WHEREAS,

some 60,000 assaults against law enforcement officers are reported each year, resulting in approximately 16,000 injuries; and

WHEREAS,

since the first recorded death in 1791, over 19,000 law enforcement officers in the United States have made the ultimate sacrifice and been killed in the line of duty, including two local sacrifices who were each members of the Mesa County Sheriff's Office and Fruita Police Department; and

WHEREAS,

the names of these dedicated public servants are engraved on the walls of the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial in Washington, D.C.; and

WHEREAS,

317 new names of fallen heroes are being added to the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial this spring, including 162 officers killed in 2010; and

WHEREAS,

the service and sacrifice of all officers killed in the line of duty will be honored during the Law Enforcement Officers Annual Candlelight Vigil, on the evening of Thursday, May 19, 2011, in Grand Junction; and

WHEREAS,

the Candlelight Vigil is part of National Police Week, which takes place this year on May 15 through May 21; and

WHEREAS,

May 15 is designated as Peace Officers Memorial Day, in honor of all fallen officers and their families.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tom Kenyon, by the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of Grand Junction, do hereby proclaim May 15 through May 21, 2011, as

in the City of Grand Junction, and publicly salute the service of law enforcement officers in our community and in communities across the nation.
