

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, The building at 601 Main Street was originally constructed in 1906; and

WHEREAS, The building has housed many businesses over the years including a hay and feed company, a mission hall and a tent and awning company in 1919, Wagoner Tire Co. in 1928, Norfords clothing store from 1939 until 1949, and it was home to the Fashion Bar clothing store in 1949; and

WHEREAS, Norm and Steb Sherwood purchased the building in 1992 from the Levy family; and

WHEREAS, Randy Hammonds Golf & Tennis has occupied the building for the last 11 years; and

WHEREAS, The Extreme Makeover was designed to compliment the Avalon Theatre and other recent building improvements in downtown Grand Junction; and

WHEREAS, The project has been a labor of love and the spirit behind that effort is Norm and Steb Sherwood's desire to give back to the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bruce Hill, by the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of Grand Junction, do hereby proclaim the building at 601 Main Street as

“The Sherwood Building”

in the City of Grand Junction and express appreciation to Norm and Steb Sherwood for their dedication to downtown Grand Junction .
